Our Cabernet Sauvignon contains some of the finest vineyards from the heart of the Napa Valley. Stratton Lummis Cabernet Sauvignon is always a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon with Petite Verdot. While the percentages of each changes by vintage, the primary sub-appellations are Oakville and Rutherford. Old friendships allow us access to some very highly regarded Estates. Because we sell our wine well below the price of most Napa Cabernet Sauvignons, we have made a promise never to reveal the names of these properties.

Aromas: Cassis mixed with dark cherry fruit and chocolate.
After airing slight hints of violets and lavender appear.

Flavors: Dark fruit flavors with mild acidity and smooth full body.
This California Cabernet Sauvignon finesses to Bordeaux.

By the Glass: Rich but not overbearing. This wine pleases by itself.

At the Table: Tasty with just a simple steak, this wine also pairs beautifully with Chefs' most complex dishes. This is a wine made to go with food.

A note from the winemaker: *We are a winemaker driven company. That means we make this wine because the winemaker wants to. Not because we own the property. It is our belief that the best Cabernet Sauvignon Vineyards have been privately owned since the early 1970s. As a winemaker, I could not turn down the opportunity to work with some of these estates. I am also old school and think wines should be priced fairly.*
